The Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital (RNOH) has a world-class reputation for pioneering treatment and excellence in orthopaedics. It provides a range of treatment, from surgery on the most acute spinal injury or complex bone tumour, to surgery for hip disorders or curvature of the spine in children. As a national and international centre of excellence, the hospital treats over 90,000 patients annually.



The RNOH's main site in Stanmore is revered internationally, and this is entirely down to the dedication and expertise of our staff, who operate from a series of 100-year-old buildings and a collection of Portakabins and Nissen huts which date back to the Second World War.

The RNOH is now entering a new and exciting era. PFI funding has been secured to replace the old buildings with a new NHS orthopaedic hospital, which will be fully operational by 2016.



The new RNOH will include:

124 inpatient beds, the large majority of which will be in single rooms, to allow patients greater privacy

Comprehensive imaging services for diagnosis and treatment, including two state-of-the-art MRI scanners, a CT scanner, x-ray and ultrasound equipment



A new spinal cord injury centre to enable rehabilitation to begin immediately following admission to the RNOH

A modern and welcoming children's unit with play facilities, to lessen the stress of a hospital stay

Site-wide catering facilities, and a new hospital main entrance with café and retail facilities
